	2. Does the IEP identify all your child's needs that result from his/her disability?
	3. Does the IEP include measurable goals/objectives?
	4. Are the measurable goals/objectives based on your child's present levels of academic achievement and functional performance (PLAAFP)? Does the PLAAFP include data from a variety of sources?
	5. Does the IEP describe how and when the school will measure your child's progress toward the goals/objectives?
	6. Does the IEP specify when you will receive updates/reports on your child's progress toward the goals/objectives?
	7. Does the IEP include a statement of the supplementary aids and services, special education services, and related services that the school will provide?
	8. Does the IEP include the projected date services will begin? Frequency? Location? Duration of Services?
	9. Does the IEP allow your child to make progress in the general curriculum and participate in extracurricular and other nonacademic activities?
	10. Does the IEP include an explanation of the extent to which your child will be educated with children who are non-disabled?

**IMPORTANT:** The function of this checklist is to serve as a reference to aid in making sure your child's IEP includes all the required components and is individualized as required by the Individual with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

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
